Come unto Jesus, rest in His love.

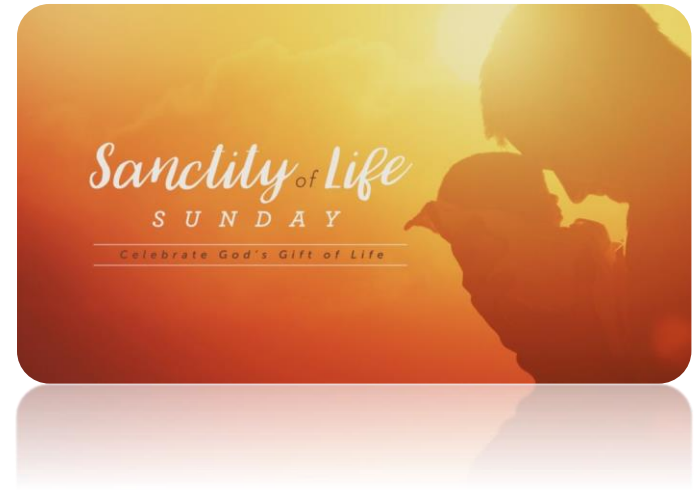
Come taste the Bread of Life, broken for sinners;
