But the ones Jesus loves? Raised from Death's dark Gaol!

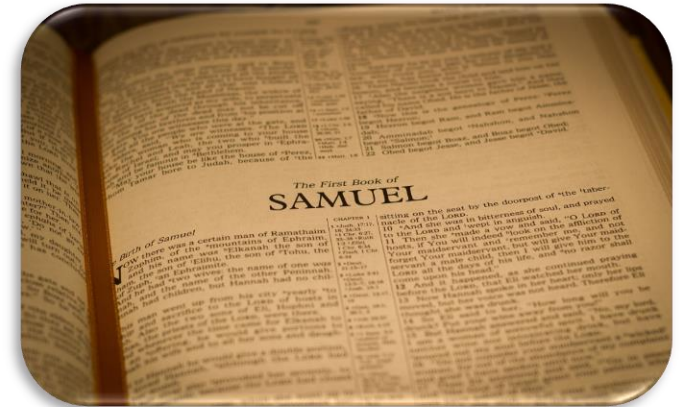
God brings poverty and riches. He brings low; he exalts...
