Oh, You rescue the souls of men.

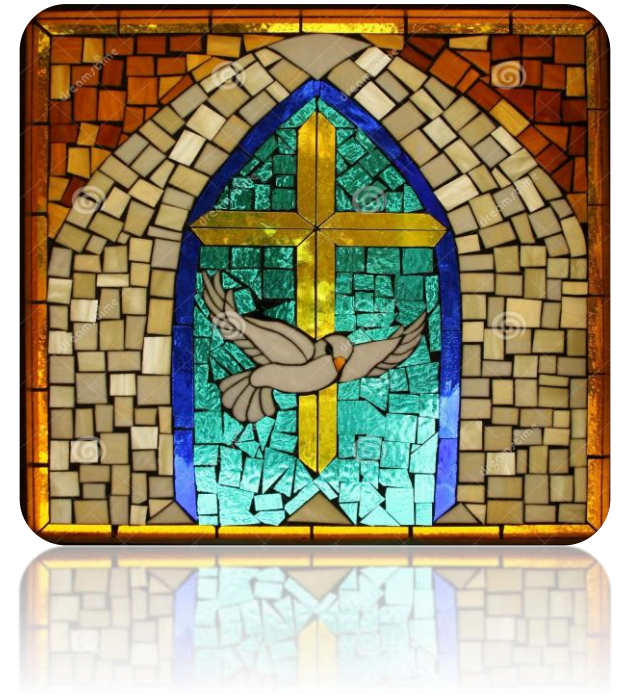
