A life laid down And ready to follow.

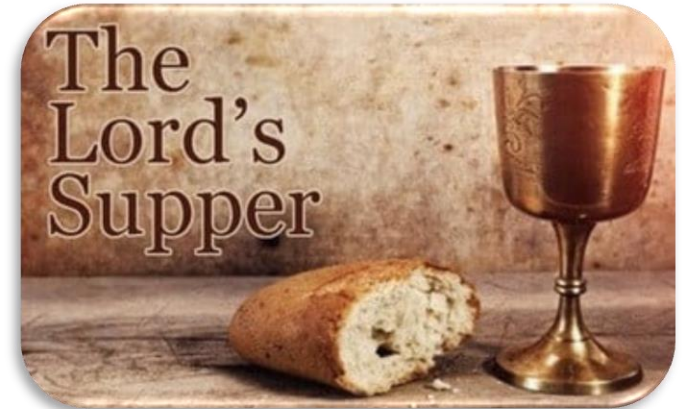
The troubled find their peace, In true surrender.
