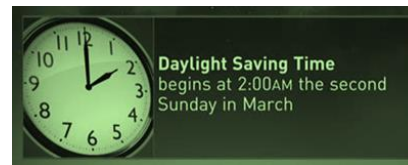
All are welcome to stay following the service for our monthly **Family Fellowship Meal** on the patio.
