 Oh the power of Christ, Word of God, Word of life.

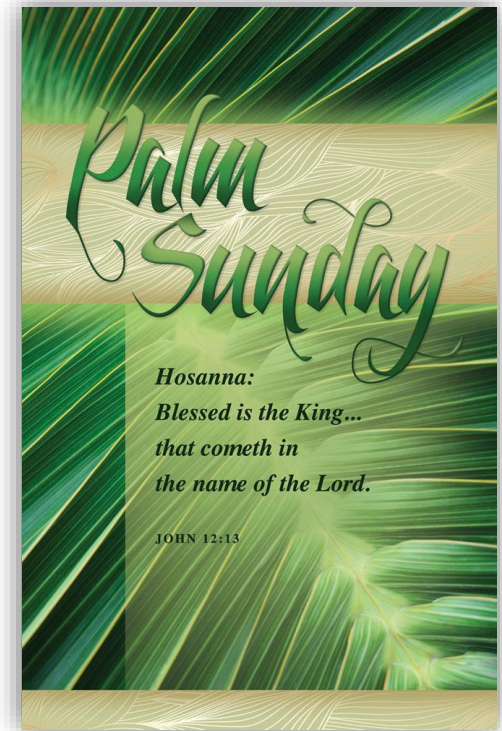
My soul longs to walk closer with the Lord I serve
