I stand redeemed by grace alone.

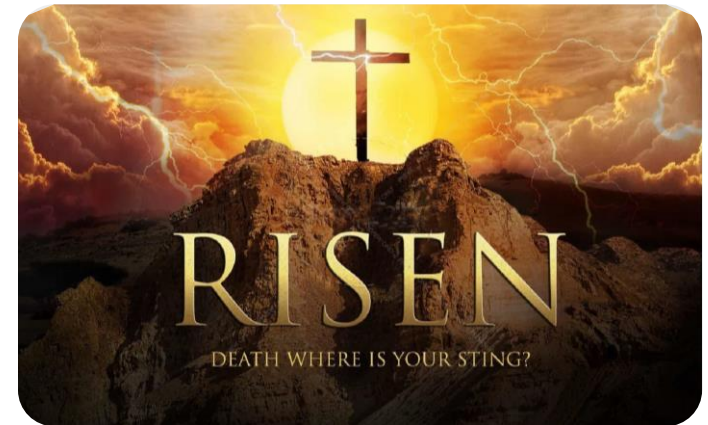
*I will wait for You, I will wait for You,
