Give us grace to see more clearly, You are God and we are not.

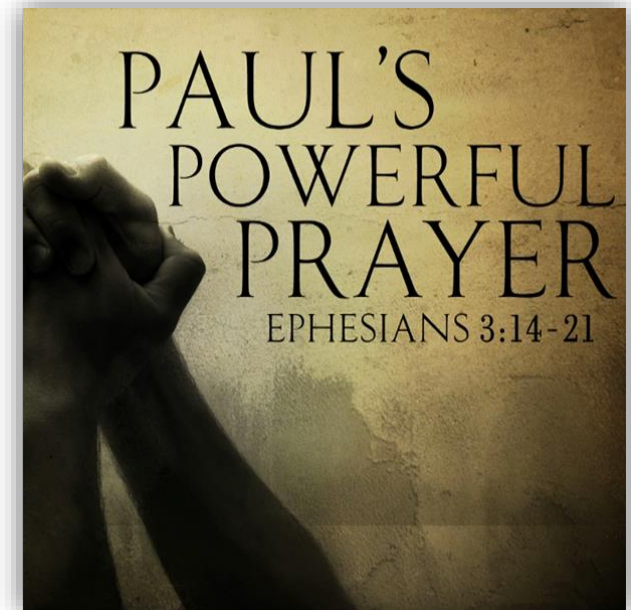
Christ our wisdom, be our gladness, When we fail to understand
