and glory give to God alone!

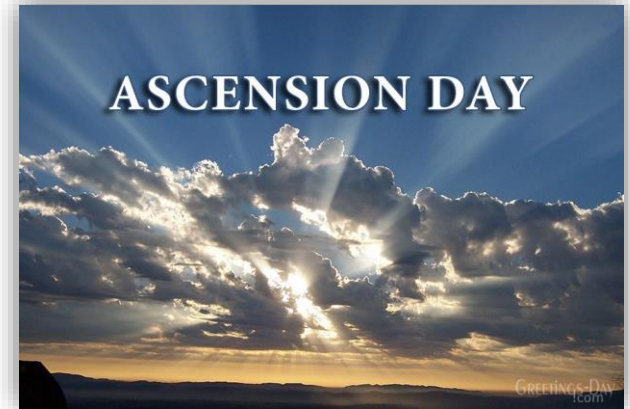
2 No one can counsel God all-wise
