And the Spirit which you sent into my life!

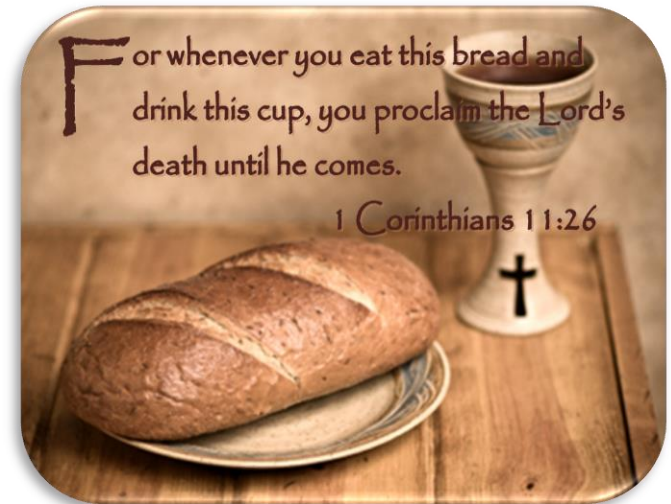
One the object of our journey,
