HYMN OF THE MONTH: O HOW GOOD IT IS

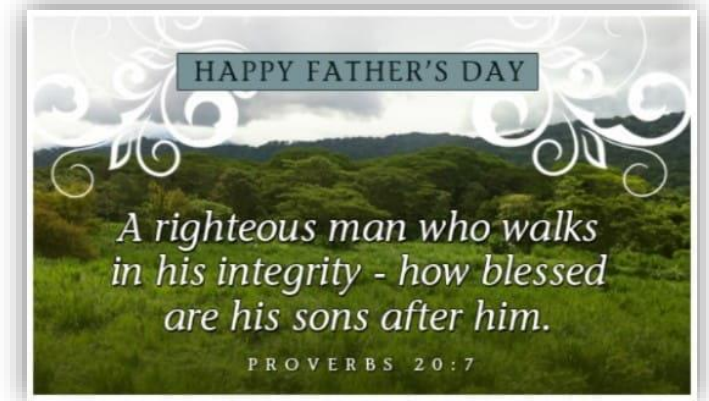
Oh, how good it is when the family of God
