Are the fruit of His presence here among us.

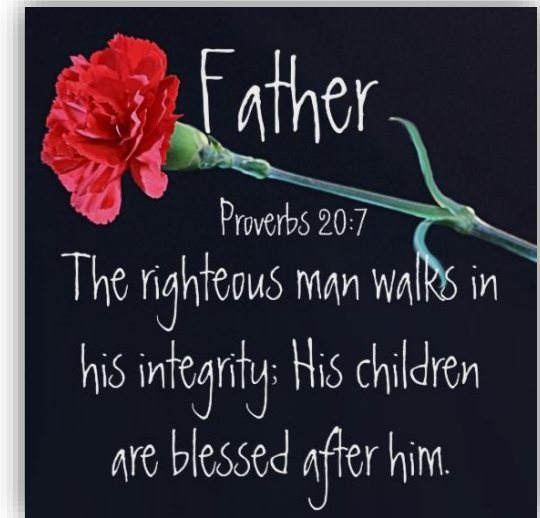
Refrain: So with one voice we'll sing to the Lord;
