When we offer the blessing of belonging. **(CHORUS)**

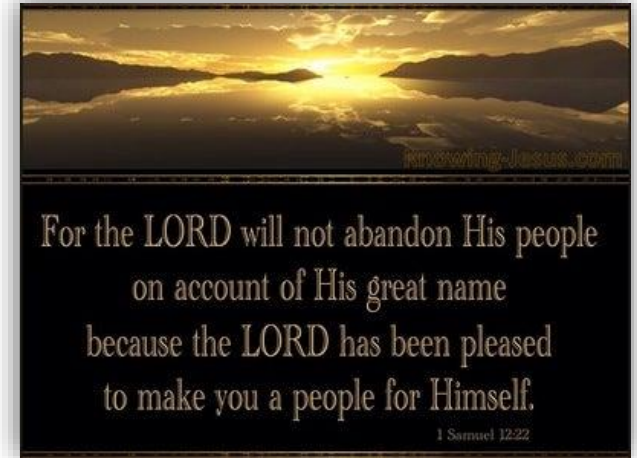
Oh, how good it is to embrace his command

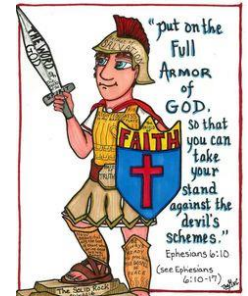
