Standing face to face with He who died and rose again, Holy, holy is the Lord

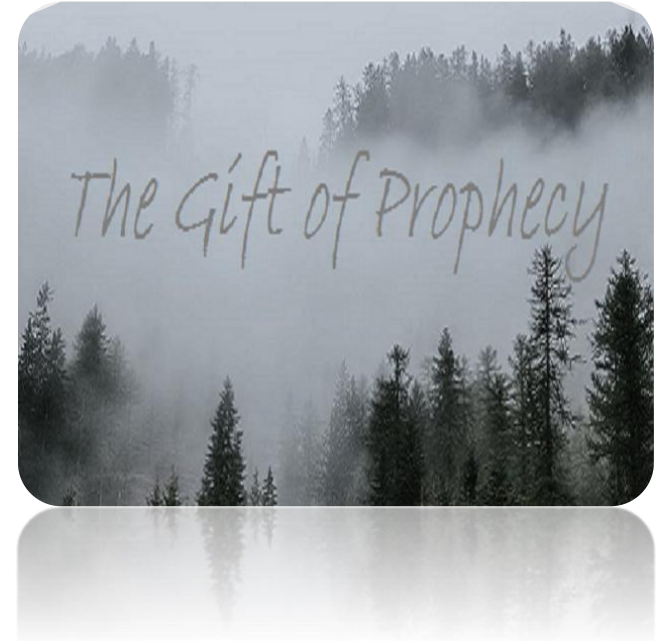
