Oh God, the battle belongs to You

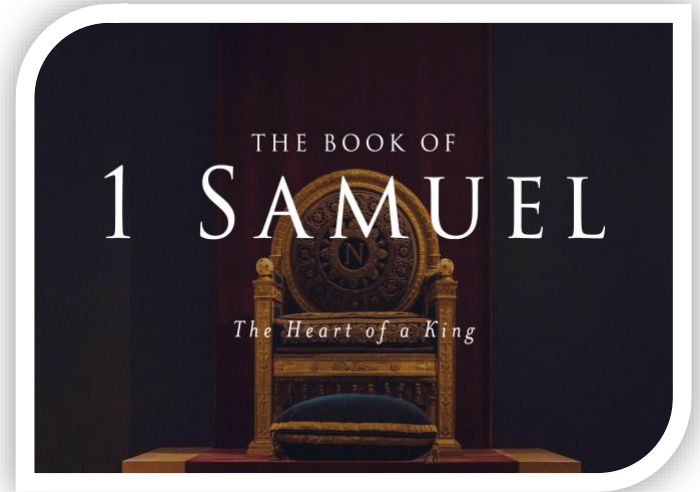
And if You are for me, who can be against me? Yeah
