Jesus Christ, my living hope. (2x)

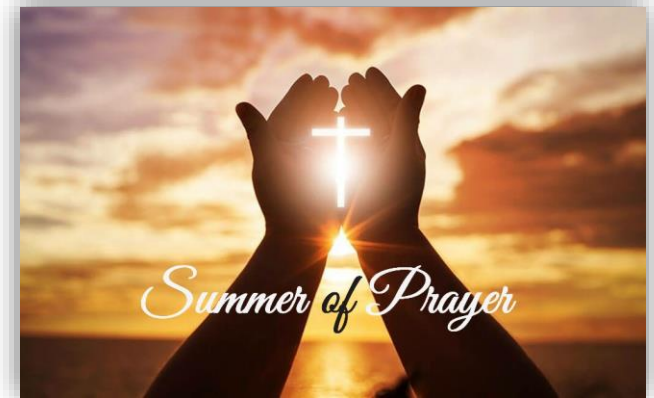
Then came the morning that sealed the promise, Your buried body began to breathe
