The CPC Session, during its initial meeting as the Board of New Geneva School, adopted a budget of \$145,000 for the 2024-25 school year. It is anticipated that most of this amount will be covered by tuition and various fundraisers. The Board/Session reminds the congregation that our church budget includes a line item designated as Christian Education Fund. Parents of New Geneva School students are asked to make their tuition payments to Calaveras Presbyterian Church, since the school is now an official ministry of CPC, rather than a private proprietary school. The CPC Session has previously encouraged all families with school-age children to attend NGS as part of our commitment to Christian education. All members and relatives of CPC children are encouraged to contribute extra gifts to the Christian Education Fund. Scholarships for needy CPC children may be made available from that fund.
