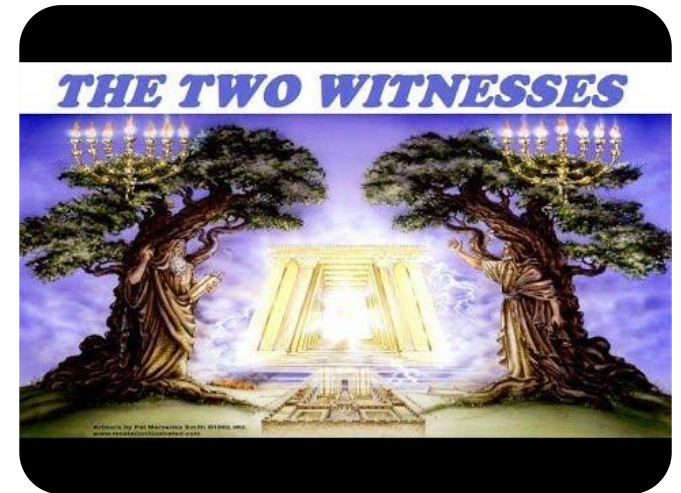
### HYMN OF THE MONTH: GOOD IS THE LORD AND FULL OF KIND COMPASSION
