Hallelujah, hallelujah, For the Lord our God the Almighty reigns

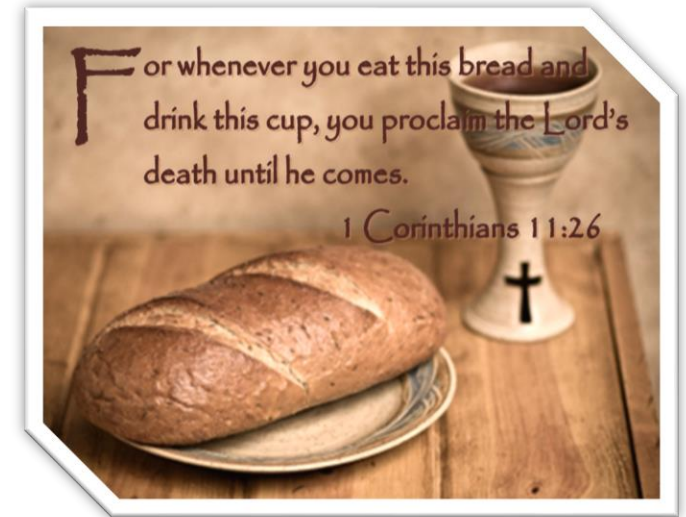
2. We will join the feast, rest from battles won
