Oh, we've hopelessly lost the way.

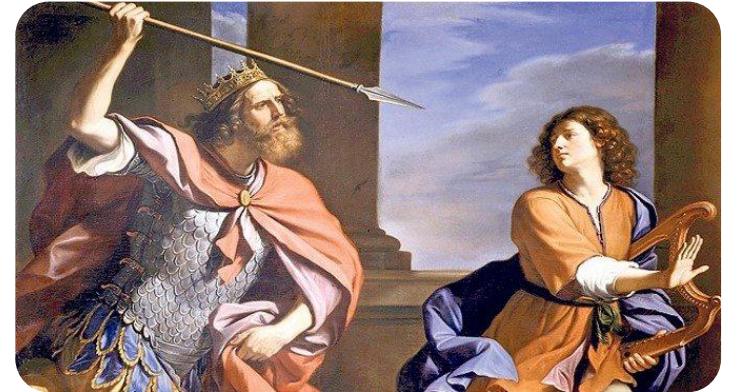
