And I will glory forever, In what the cross has done

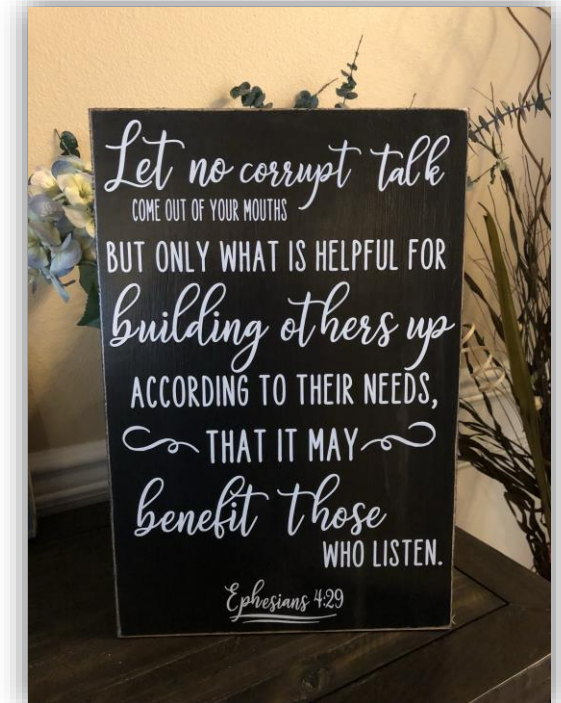
O praise the One forever blessed, Him alone my heart adores

### SO WHAT ARE YOUR PLANS FOR TODAY?

**Westminster Confession of Faith:** Chapter 21, Paragraph 8, of the Confession emphasizes that the Sabbath (or Lord's Day) is to be observed as a day of rest and worship. It states that the entire day should be devoted to public and private worship, and not only should one cease from his or her regular work but also avoid unnecessary activities that detract from the day's sanctity.

**Westminster Shorter Catechism:** In question 60, the Shorter Catechism explains that the Sabbath is a day to rest from ordinary works and to engage in worship and spiritual activities. The answer indicates that this day is for both public and private worship and should be spent in activities that promote spiritual growth.
