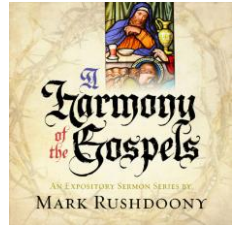

Pastor Moes was examined and officially ordained as a minister of the Gospel Thursday at the Reformed Presbyterian Church Hanover Presbytery meeting in Savannah, Georgia.

The **Adult Sunday School class** has begun a new series of lessons by Elder Mark Rushdoony exploring the Harmony of the Gospels. The four Gospels contain so much that they tend to be studied, discussed, and preached as many independent teachings, as "sound bites" from God. If they are studied piecemeal, however, the context is often lost. More importantly, the relation of one set of events or teachings to those which either precede or follow is then lost. Without the flow of the history of the ministry of Christ, the questions to Christ and his responses can seem abstract and "spiritual" when they, in fact, were about practical, real-life issues. In a chronological approach, the flow of history unfolds.
