For my God is, the Ancient of Days **[Chorus 1]**

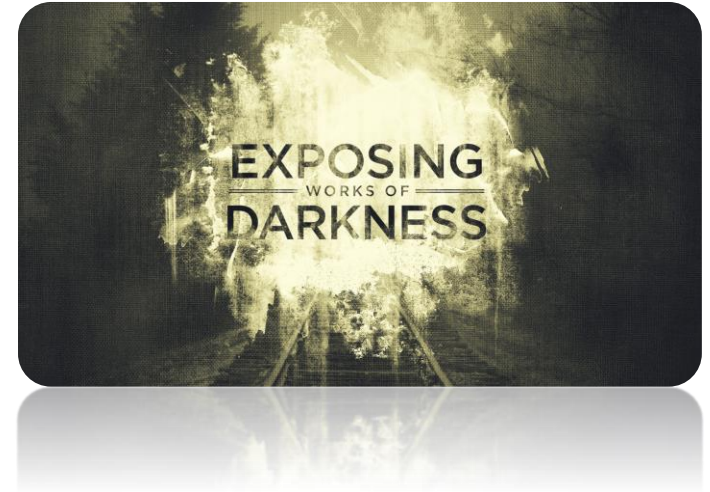
