My song of praise shall ever be: The Father's love for me.

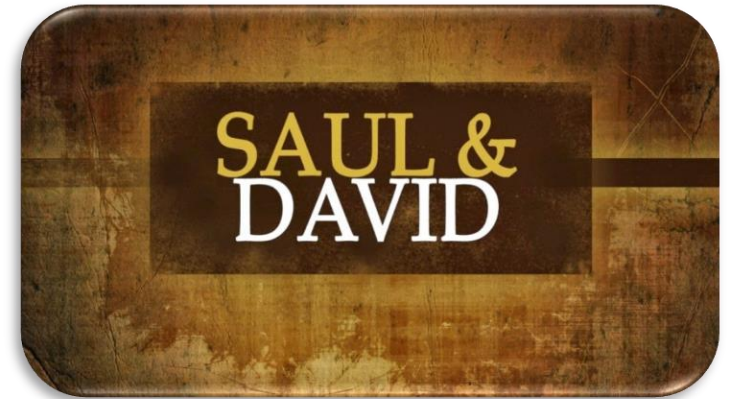
Love of God, revealed in frailty, Through the gift of a servant King;
