We are children of His promise, Heirs of mercy and grace divine.

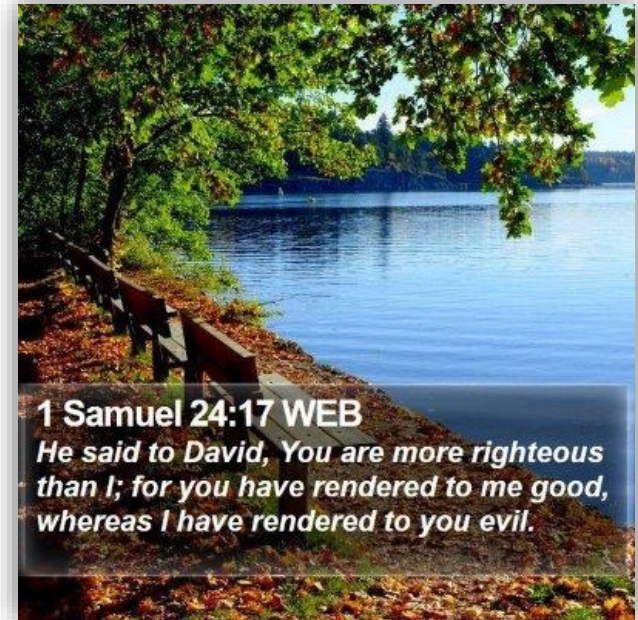
**REFRAIN:** Unfailing love from heaven's throne,
