Come praise with me in grateful songs.

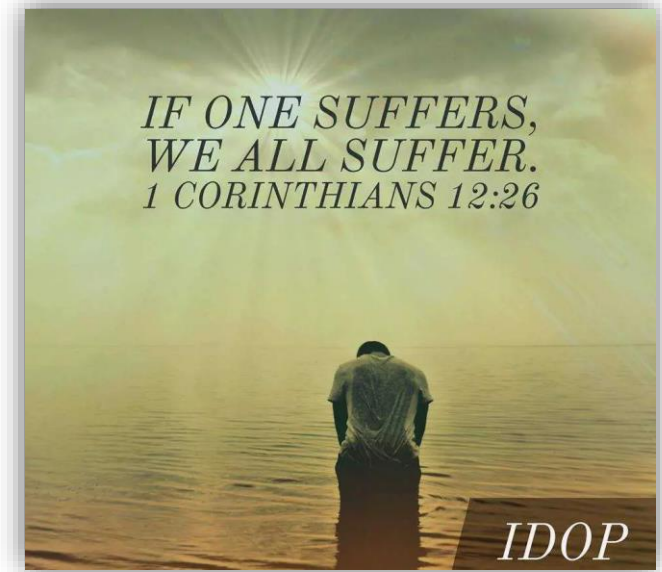
Within His gates thanksgivings raise.
