By blood and not by merit,

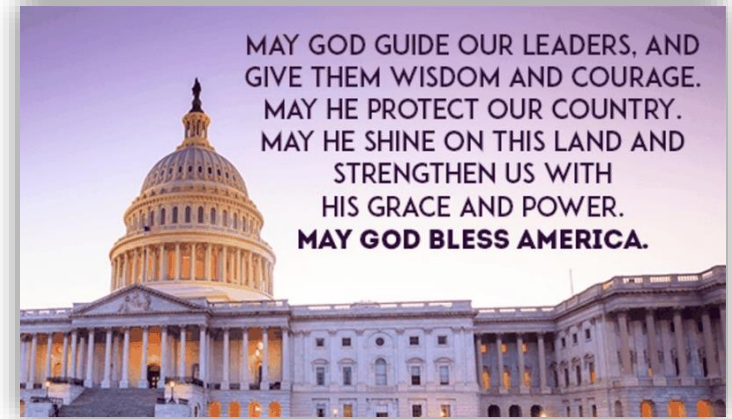
Your grace that reaches far and wide
