HYMN OF THE MONTH:

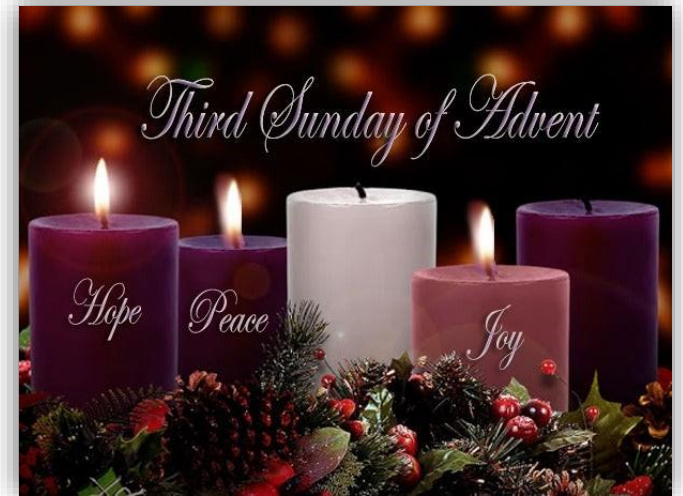
“BREAK FORTH, O BEAUTEOUS HEAVENLY LIGHT”

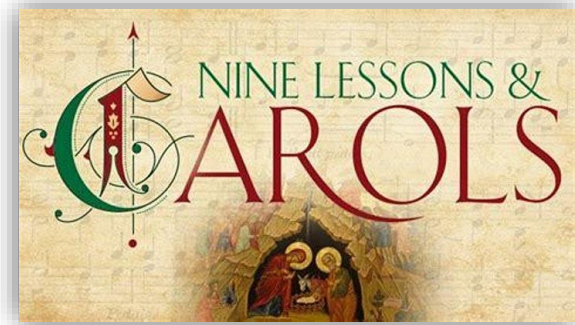
